7. **REPORTS FROM OFFICERS**
 - a. **Report from Police Chief:** The Department wrote 114 citations for the month of February ranging from driving under suspension, drugs, driving under the influence; normal things. Worked 48 cases and had some things happen at the cemetery which was disturbing but all and all things are going well.
 - b. **Report from Library Director:** Since my last report we've added 24 new patrons. We had a very successful reception in January with Representative Babinec and Senator Dugger. We now have a ukulele the public can check out, this came from a program out of Stillwater. A spring break movie was shown this week, the Friends of the Library continue to pay for the Movie License each year. There is a class coming up where you can learn to make salsa as well as learn to dance the salsa on April 4th. Summer reading is progressing, we've received some good donations so far this year. We were chosen for a pilot program to check out hot spots, unfortunately the carrier was Sprint we don't have that coverage at the library so we had to drop it. We have a Community Service worker that has worked about 45 hours and home school students continue to meet at the library. We bought a chair rack that will hold all of the folding chairs at the library, we also bought a dual sided chalk board sign that we can put daily announcements and activities going on at the library that we'll sit just outside the door.
 - c. **Report from City Manager:** We have 2 employees enrolled for Class D Water/Wastewater licensing. Kirby Smith is coming out to give us an estimate on the brakes for the grader. Chickasaw was out today to look at siren locations. The one we're moving on Beaumont is a 3-phase so it'll go behind the new gym otherwise we would have to sit a new pole and transformer to accommodate it. The new siren will be on the West side and the old siren will be on the East side. On the East side they may have to move it back just a little but other than that it should be fine. We moved the dumpsters out of the park because it was becoming a junk pile, we moved the big can by the show

barn and we put 4 cans in the cemetery. Tim had rings made for the streets, each hole is a different size so he'll have to measure each one for a custom ring to be cut; Supreme Machine is making the rings. Moore Iron & Steel made a new grate for the area at C and Boston, free of charge.
